Dear Friends,

Back in July 2020, we headed into fiscal year 2021 as the pandemic threw normalcy out the window. In the fog of so much uncertainty, we were nonetheless clear that our mission was more vital than ever before.

We adapted almost all of our courses to be offered online, including the free instruction provided to underserved clients through our Mindfulness Mentors program. We piloted new Interfaith Spirituality programs. We expanded our Social Compassion courses, including our racial equity series, engaging minds, hearts, and hands in helping to build a more just and equitable community. We also offered new courses to foster dialogue and nonviolent communication.

To promote Care for the Earth, we led weekly educational hikes, grew produce for local food banks, launched our new Deep Ecology Environmental Justice Internship program, continued to engage Environmental Interns, facilitated a new monthly Earth Advocates group, and developed virtual nature field trips for local schools. We also safely resumed our Camp Odyssey summer camps.

The pandemic gave us the gift of having to take strategic risks amidst uncertainty. We made two full-time hires this year and it is already paying dividends. Our new Development Director is building a robust fundraising program and our new Program Manager is implementing new programs that will reach thousands of youth each year. We will continue to extend our reach and impact through expanded audiences and programming. And we have an exciting new outdoor construction project underway that we can't wait to tell you more about soon.

It's a thrilling time of evolution and growth leading to a stronger, more robust community of transformative learning and service. We are immensely grateful for your support, making our work possible. Thank you.





#### **Accountability & Transparency**

The Earth & Spirit Center is a BBB Accredited Charity, meeting all 20 standards of Charity Accreditation. Our fundraising expense ratio of fundraising expenses to total development income for the 2020–2021 fiscal year is 20%. This is higher than previous year averages due to the addition of a full-time Development Director, but still well below the BBB standard of 35% or less. We expect this number to continue to decrease again over time as we increase our fundraising revenue. We have a Gold Star Seal of transparency on GuideStar, a national non-profit rating database. We are dedicated to maximizing our resources, maintaining the highest level of financial responsibility, and investing in long-term organizational sustainability.


