Responsibilities

- Lead mission-aligned lessons for groups of K-6 campers, educating campers on compassion for the earth, themselves, and others through hands-on, fun activities.
- Ensure an exceptional camp experience by creating a positive, energetic camp environment.
- Create and teach curriculum according to their subject. Activity examples are available.
- Must commit to at least one full week of camp, either part- time or full-time.
- Ensure safety of campers at all times and accurately fill out safety incident forms.
- Organize activity supplies in advance and maintain a clean activity station each day.
- Arrive on time each day and communicate schedule changes in advance with the Camp Director

Requirements

- Must be 18 or older
- Must have an interest and commitment to the Passionist Earth & Spirit Center mission
- Must have a passion for serving and working directly with children
- Comfortable leading ages 5-11 years, 25 campers per group, 4-5 counselors per group.
- Comfortable working outdoors in various weather conditions
- Must submit information for and pass a background check
- Pay is \$25/hour
- First Aid Certification preferred
- Teaching experience with children of at least 2 years
- Must have Safe Environment Training or be willing to acquire training after being hired
- Must be present for all training and orientation
